Blood Donation Service Project



Vocational Program for Girls



- \$620 been sent already.
- This program will support 25 girls for the next year.
- Eight sewing machines - they will learn sewing.
- Cloth material for girls to use for sewing
- Two computers - they will learn typing and basic Microsoft Office.
- Salary for two teachers - one teacher to teach sewing and one to teach computers
- The ultimate goal is for every young girl in that village to become self-reliant and independent.
- Tim and Kathy will donate \$315, Liz Bush Cooper will donate \$315, Tabatha and Ned Hale to donate \$200. Total will be \$830.

Meeting wit Kiwanis Edison Club



- Met with the Kiwanis Edison club on Thursday, July 20th, 2023
- September 11th to September 17th is the Rotary collaboration week. Clubs are encouraged to do a joint project with a local Kiwanis/Lions/Optimist clubs.
- We discussed the Imagination Library project that will be led by Kathy from our club.



Operation SAFE Launch



- A Recover Center for Girls Rescued from Sex-Trafficking. This project is intended to benefit survivors of domestic minor sex trafficking that are in the foster care system in Texas.
- This is a global grant. Eleven clubs worldwide, including the Rotary Club of Babcock Ranch, have participated in this project.
- Our club has donated \$500 towards this project.
- Rotary International is the final step of formalizing the grant.
- RI will start implementing the necessary actions within the next one week. We will get regular monthly updates on the progress of this global project.

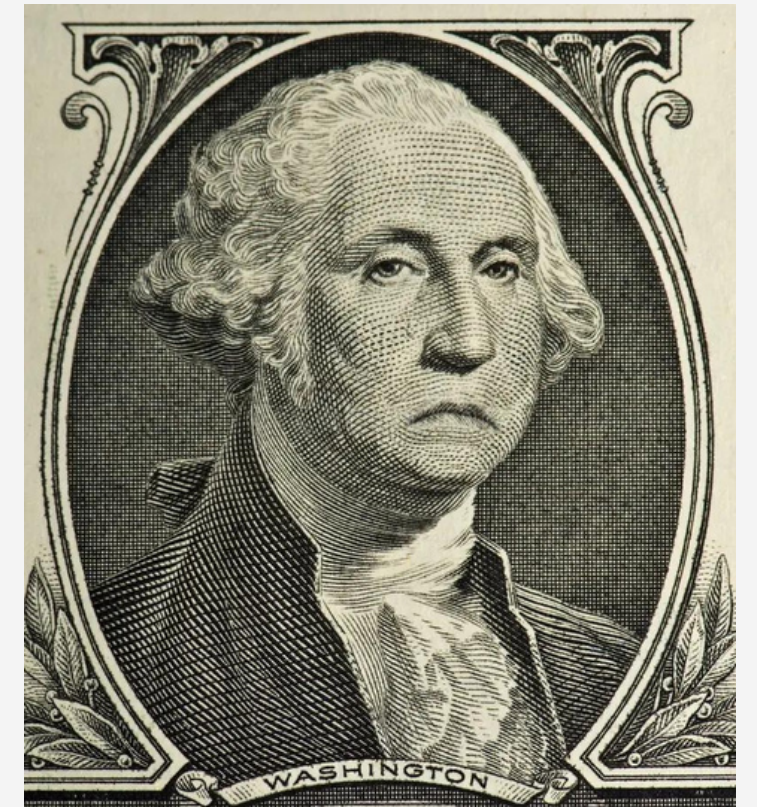
