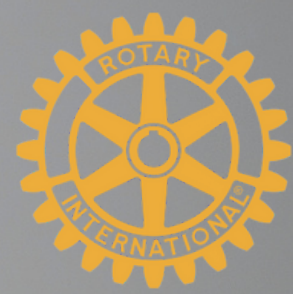

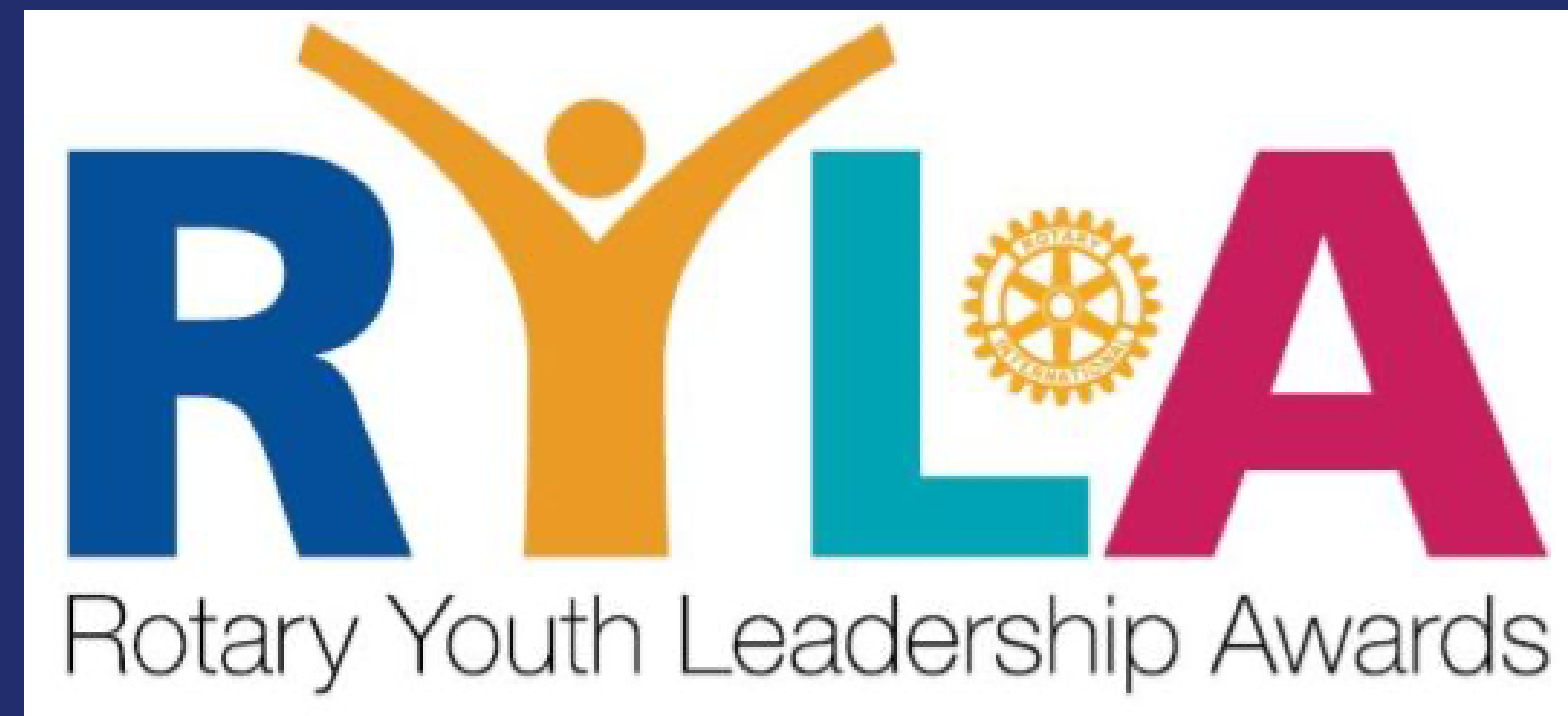
Holiday Extravaganza - December 9th, 2023

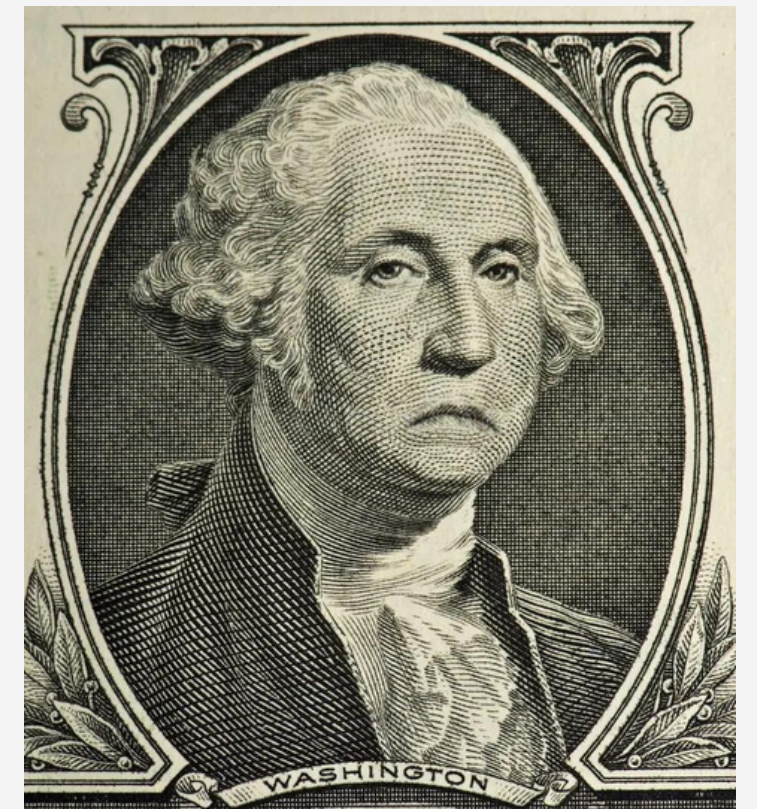
